



## *Cabernet Sauvignon* 2016

### **Tasting Characteristics:**

Medium garnet to red in colour, berry and forest fruits dominate the aroma balanced with cedar from French oak. The palate is soft and juicy with classic red fruit flavours supported by mature and fine tannins to produce a wine of immediate appeal.

12 months French oak

Wilyabrup sub-region, Margaret River
